# CPR PROGRAM

#### STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

A student is eligible for the CPR program if he/she is retained for **ANY** of the following reasons:

• Grades 1 - 5 Final Yearly Average below 70 in any of the following subjects: reading/language, mathematics, science or social studies.

## PARENT NOTIFICATION

Parents/guardians will be notified of student's eligibility for the summer program on or before the final report card and/or by mail. Contact your home campus after June 1, 2021, with any questions on registration.

## SUMMER PROGRAM PROMOTION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Students may not be absent for more than two (2) days of the summer program AND
- 2. Students must successfully complete the required academic tasks.

#### SUMMER PROGRAM SITES

- Students eligible for the CPR program will attend at the host campus site. See table below:
- \*Students from these campuses will be required to attend the 21st Century program after attending the CPR summer program.

# **BILINGUAL PROGRAM**

## STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

A student is eligible for the Bilingual summer program if he/she:

- Receives a special information packet inviting him/her to participate in the summer Bilingual program.
